PARADE RULES AND REGULATIONS

The PAFCOM Parade Committee has outlined a list of PARADE Rules and Regulations to ensure a more enjoyable participation and impact to which the participants to comply with.

- 1) No items, objects, products, or giveaways maybe thrown from any float, car, and vehicle or by the marchers. If there are giveaways, it should be handed to the spectators.
- 2) No balloons maybe released by any participant.
- 3) No rollerblading and skate boarding is allowed during the parade.
- 4) A completed and signed Parade Application form must be submitted to PAFCOM, Inc. either by mail or e-mail to the Parade Co-Chair, **Michael Florendo: mike_florendo@yahoo.com** or **Maria Florendo : mariaflorendo2016@gmail.com** or to our organization email **pafcomnj@gmail.com** no later than **Monday, June 17, 2024.**
- 5) Only OPEN CARS will be permitted to join the parade.
- 6) All float designs and decorations will be provided by the participating organizations. Inappropriate theme and decorations will not be allowed in the parade.
- 7) Float can be provided by PAFCOM (upon availability) at an estimated cost of \$2,200. PAFCOM requires full payment from the intended user/organization by **May 31, 2024.**
