1. Transcript of high school records.
2. Copies of PSAT and SAT scores.
3. A Letter of recommendations from any of the following: the principal, guidance counselor, adviser/teacher.
4. A Letter of character reference from any of the following: a priest, pastor, employer, or community leader.
5. Passport size photo (colored photo)
6. An essay of 350 words on the theme: ***“Education is the Passport to the Future, for Tomorrow Belongs to those who Prepare for it Today”.***

Financial Needs	15%
Interview	10%

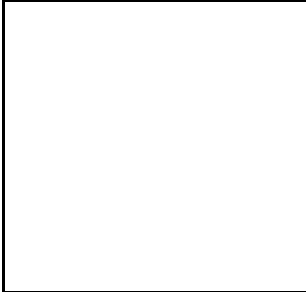
